The main responsibility of SIB will be to investigate as and when a Scientific misconduct is reported (anonymous complaints shall not be entertained unless is accompanied by factual and verifiable data), find facts and make recommendations for punitive action. The SIB would do due diligence including interaction with the concerned Scientific/technical staff, examine the records and suggest the suitable punitive action commensurate with the offence done and shall submit its report to the Director, CSIR-CSMCRI. The SIB shall refer to levels of misconduct and suggest advice on the action to be taken as per the above-mentioned CSIR guidelines.

The Director, CSIR-CSMCRI will nominate external member(s) depending on the nature of the case as and when an issue is received by the SIB. The Chairperson/Alternate Chairperson of SIB can co-opt members as deemed appropriate for the investigation from the Institute.

The tenure of the Committee will be two years from the date of this notification.
